Lebenshilfe Bocholt-Rhede-Isselburg e.V. undergoing debtorin-possession proceedings – Dr Brüninghoff appointed provisional insolvency monitor

Attorney Mr Sebastian Scheuer from law firm Stellmach & Bröckers, acting on behalf of the board of Lebenshilfe Bocholt-Rhede-Isselburg e.V. and management at Lebenshilfe Bocholt Wohnen gemeinnützige GmbH in his capacity as general agent, has applied to the Local Court of Münster for the opening of debtor-in-possession insolvency proceedings. The court has approved the applications and appointed Dr Ria Brüninghoff from PLUTA Rechtsanwalts GmbH as provisional insolvency monitor to protect the interests of the overall body of creditors in both proceedings.

"Lebenshilfe's cost structure is unbalanced, with expenses outstripping revenues despite pandemic-related one-off effects," explained the general agent. "We are optimistic about the prospects for an operational restructuring. People with disabilities and their relatives and carers will still have the same points of contact during the debtor-in-possession insolvency proceedings. The association is continuing to pursue its activities and provide support services."
