PLUTA Experts support Restructuring of E.V.G. Erkheim in Debtor-in-Possession Proceedings

E.V.G. – Ein- und Verkaufsgenossenschaft eG filed for debtor-in-possession proceedings with the Local Court of Memmingen two days ago. This step became inevitable due to a cash shortage.

During the debtor-in-possession proceedings, the company will undergo a comprehensive restructuring process, which will be supported by the experienced restructuring and management expert Ms. Martina Hengartner from PLUTA Rechtsanwalts GmbH. The goal is to preserve the cooperative on a long-term basis. The prefinancing of the so-called insolvency substitute benefits will be arranged during the restructuring process. The salaries of the 244 employees are secure for a period of three months thanks to these benefits.

Ms. Hengartner explains: "The prospects for successful restructuring are good. As usual, the customers and members of the cooperative can rely on the quality of the goods. The debtor-in-possession proceedings give us the chance to restructure the cooperative in such a way that it has a viable future. One can feel that all those involved are prepared to look forward."
